- I am aware of the fact that my learners have different levels of skills in the use of technology and I know how to handle this.
- I am aware of data protection issues and know how to act accordingly in my courses.
- I am aware of the meaning of OER licenses, I am able to search for OER material that I can use in my courses and I know how to label my own contents adequately.



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
