



Beneficiaries and Outputs

The direct beneficiaries of the project are the trainers who work with vulnerable adults (migrants, unemployed, etc...) and the managers of the training centers. The indirect beneficiaries will be training participants, local authorities and training centers.

The project will develop two Intellectual Outputs:

- a blended course intended for trainers, integrated with a tools bank useful for building one's own lessons and programs;
- a digital handbook to promote teaching strategies and digital tools for teaching.

2nd Transnational Meeting

October 11th – 12th, 2021

On 11th and 12th October took place the second transnational project meeting (TPM) in hybrid mode due to the Covid restrictions. The Italian, Spanish, Bulgarian and English partners met in Lecco (Italy), while the German and the Turkish ones attended online.

The meeting was the occasion for an overall update about project implementation and for sharing ideas and opinions about how to work on IO3: a digital handbook on online and offline promotional strategies of educational offers for adult educators and educational managers.

Partners agreed on the topics to cover and decided who will develop each of them. Usak University took on the responsibility to prepare a template for the development of each module.



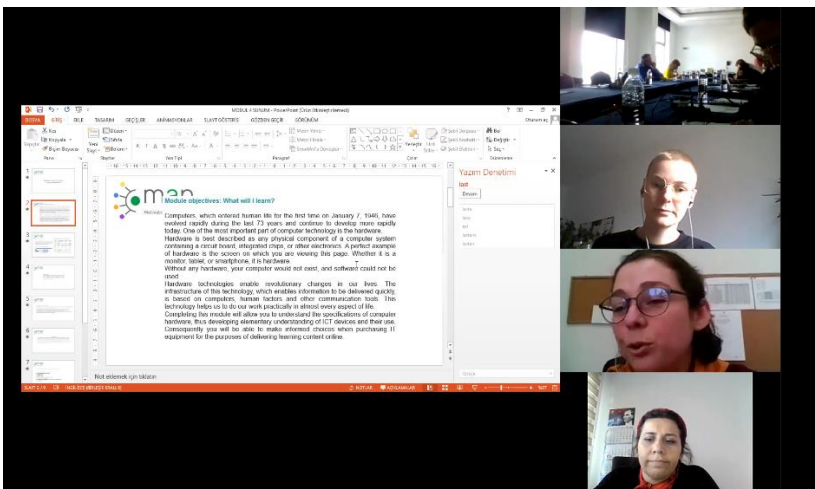
Learning, Teaching, Training Activity
